

SEWER COMMITTEE MEETING NOTES

Sept. 11, 2025

Attendees: Supervisor Mike Dvorchak, Deputy Supervisor Bart Ziegler, Town Clerk Robina Ward, Les Coons of H2O, George Schmidt of CPL

1. Absorption bed project

- a. Materials needed will be ordered shortly
 - b. Contractors: Mike has asked several local contractors about their availability
 - c. Schedule- as soon as possible. This needs to be done before winter.
 - d. DEC approval – George to follow up with James Malcolm.

2. Generator: Service person coming this month. We are awaiting a renewed service contract.

3. Testing of outflow by Adirondack: Committee discussed the results; Les will study them and the Robina will pass them along to the DEC. Mike will share with the Town Board and post in the agenda.

4. Heater issue: Les says the heater doesn't work and advises the town to order a new one. Mike to investigate cost.

5. Pumping of grease traps at restaurants: Mike says this is now done on a quarterly schedule. Pumping other 47 tanks: Mike will discuss a schedule with Robina and come up with a spreadsheet of a pumping schedule. Robina to confirm grease trap pumping.

6. The replacement sewer panel at Anthony Street home under renovation has been installed. The owner has sent a check for reimbursement.

7. Les reported that the sewer plant's operation is status quo; his team is cleaning one pod per day. Operations have much improved.

8. George says the town will be ordering a new pump chamber as part of the rehabilitation project.

INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE MEETING NOTES

1. Moving streetlight poles: Paperwork has been submitted. Mike spoke with the contractor to schedule work for this fall.

2. Hamlet Park renovation:
 - a. New Maple Street entrance: Project is on hold until we have more information on possible new entrance from Route 22
 - b. Bandshell: CPL will work on a siting plan. Bart to present several options for public input.

3. Mitchell Street culvert – George to check out after meeting ends.

4. Salt Shed – waiting on grant award notification.

5. Anthony/Coldwater Street sidewalks: Committee discussed the need for surveys showing the rights of way in preparation for July 2026 state grant application. The Town will be reapplying for the grant.
