Insulation of sheds and sink – 90 percent complete, Mike says

Postmortem on Rehab—George: The project is substantially complete, site is stabilized, waiting for hatches to pump chamber and valve pit; have temp hatches in place; these are included in project cost. Reprogramming of the PLC needs to close the loop. George will present the final paperwork when completed.

LES: Will go over reprogramming of PLC with George; amp loads need adjustment; will also have them adjust dosing pumps to work properly.

Mike: Overall, the project went well and on time; DEC is pleased; thanks go to the highway department for its assistance

George: The plant is working correctly now. We had a meeting with DEC on site, and they commented that it's the best it ever looked as far as the effluent.

DEC is redoing all permits in the area over the next few years; they will examine the plant and then reissue the permit.
