1. Reprogramming – the plant is dosing, but we are not getting notification. Jim Chandler needs to be contacted. Mike will be contacting Chandler.
2. Cleaning out of pumps at the plant – Les reached out to Albany Pollution Control. They have just reopened after the storm. Application requires Supervisor signature. Les will follow up with Albany, and then we can reschedule with Baldwin.
3. Increased I&I during the storm – we saw a significant increase. We are investigating loose tank covers at 47 Coldwater and 014 Anthony. Mike will check on the cost of lid replacements. Lee will be checking basements for sump pumps.
4. Les will approach the village of Red Hook in a possible partnership in purchasing individual alarms for each tank. Les will let us know about the price.
5. Mike has sent a soil sample to Cornell for analysis. The grass is growing, but we could use more growth.
6. Design Grant – still waiting to hear.
7. Grants have been fully received except for the remaining 12K, which has been submitted.
8. Baffles – George called in and discussed plans to filter out the solids reaching the fields. George will present a new concept drawing.
9. Cyber Security – H2O feels the risk is lower compared to other facilities. There are grants to investigate susceptibility.
