Sewer:

1. Absorption bed project is underway by the contractor. They expect to be done by early November.
2. Generator: service call on sewer generator has been made
3. Heater: Need ETA to schedule Precision
4. Pumping of Grease Traps: Will check quarterly
5. Pumping of other tanks: Robina and Mike to make spreadsheet of schedule
6. Other issues/report on calls from panel: Les says status quo
Twisted Sisters clog issue--Les is unclear what created it.

INFRASTRUCTURE

1. Moving of streetlight poles: Paperwork is near completion. Robina spoke to the Highway Dept about the possible need to temporarily store poles. Town will send letters to affected property owners. Oct. 27 is the start date by the contractor.
2. Hamlet Park
 - a. Maple Street: No developments
 - b. Bandshell: Bart will check the state list of approved bandshell vendors
 - c. Maps/Master plan: George says CPL will adjust the cost of creating the plan based in part on what the bandshell vendor covers, such as a blueprint for the foundation
3. Mitchell Street Culvert: George says it needs replacement
4. Salt Shed: Awaiting word on the grant application
5. Anthony/Coldwater Street sidewalks
 - a. Need easement for the sidewalk grant from several property owners, based on the property lines shown on the CPL map
 - b. Letter to residents of affected properties will need to be sent
