1. Update from Les on operations
 1. Reprogramming of panel – Update
 1. Status: Finished! The HMI needs to be updated onsite. We need to download to a USB drive to update the HMI on the laptop. In the interim, the program is running. Robina will schedule an appointment with Orenco to reprogram
 2. Pumping of Tank at Facility
 1. Les spoke with Baldwin. Dan Baldwin is down a truck, so he is behind schedule but is working with all other companies
