3. Brief presentation on Draft Comprehensive Plan – Susan Badtke, WCWRPC

Susan Badtke, West Central WI Regional Planning Commission, stated that she is here tonight to update the Village Board on the Comprehensive Plan. Over the last year or so Susan has been working with the Village's Plan Commission on updating the Village's Comprehensive Plan. The last plan was adopted in 2009; this is an update to that plan. Comprehensive planning is working together and having a conversation as a community to: Consider existing conditions and trends, decide what is important, identify a vision of the future and develop a guide for future growth and local decision making. Under State statutes, there are nine (9) required elements that are required to be part of a Comprehensive plan. The planning process was started back in October of 2023 with several meetings and a web-based community survey. Meetings were open to the public and full draft plans were available at the Village Hall and Chippewa Falls Library, along with the Village Web page.
