

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the city of Lake Wilson council met April 3, 2025 at 7:00pm. Present are Jolene Johnson, Kindel Nelson, Michael Chapman and Melanie Vander Schaaf

Mayor Chapman opened the meeting with the reading of the minutes of the March 6, 2025 meeting. Motion was made by Jolene and seconded by Kindel to approve the minutes as read. All members present voted 'aye'. Motion carried.

A new water heater was needed at one of the apartments.

The maintenance position was discussed. The council decided to offer a starting wage of \$25-\$27/hour depending on any experience and the requirement to get the water/sewer licenses within 3 years. Applications will be due May 1. The council will also review the personnel policy.

The council got more quotes for a lawn mower.

The council has decided to hold off on making a decision regarding a tractor.

The ambulance contract for Murray County was for 2023 -2025. The council had voted in 2023 to pay the contract. Jolene made a motion and Kindel seconded to pay the contract for a total of \$7,170.00. All members present voted 'aye'. Motion carried.

The council has gotten a bid to redo the park sign. The city would like to get it done before Town & Country Days.

The carpet should be cleaned in the fire hall and possibly city all. Kindel made a motion and Jolene seconded to get an estimate.

The fire department has some trucks that need new tires. Jolene made a motion and Kindel seconded to have them go ahead and get the tires needed. All members present voted 'aye'. Motion carried.

The council decided to have the tree taken down by the front door of the city hall before the roots cause problems with the sidewalk, driveway and foundation.

Resolution 2025-1 to allow the Currie Town & Country Boosters to do bingo for Town & Country Days was presented. Kindel made a motion and Jolene seconded to approve the resolution. All members present voted 'aye'. Motion carried.

List of claims were presented for March. Kindel made a motion and Jolene seconded to pay them. All members present voted 'aye'. Motion carried
