

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the city of Lake Wilson council met June 5, 2025 at 7:00pm. Present are Jolene Johnson, Kyle Carlson, Michael Chapman, Melanie Vander Schaaf, City Engineer Jason Zinter, Michael Berreau, and Rod Van Essen.

Mayor Chapman opened the meeting with the reading of the minutes of the May 1, 2025 meeting. Motion was made by Kyle and seconded by Jolene to approve the minutes as read. All members present voted 'aye'. Motion carried.

Michael Berreau, President of the First Responders, was asking the city to pay for their refresher training. Jolene made a motion that the city pays for the training and Kyle seconded the motion. All members voted 'aye'. Motion carried.

Jason Zinter looked at the water plant and lift station. He discussed the rehabbing versus building a new lift station and/or water plant. He also discussed the possibility of paving the streets around the new lots as well as a portion of West Street. He will have some rough estimates for the next meeting.

Rod Van Essen from Buffalo Ridge Bar informed the council about the sand volleyball league that was going to be playing in the park. He also supplied the insurance and license needed for Town & Country Days.

The roof of the one apartment building was fixed. A new water heater was also needed. The council will not pursue any additional updating loans at this time.

The new park sign will be installed this week.

The maintenance position was tabled until the next meeting since some council members were not at the meeting.

There have issues with parking on the streets that aren't allowed to be parked overnight. The clerk will put the parking ordinance in the newsletter.

The office computer will no longer be supported after October 1, 2025. It can be updated for \$300 or get a new one for \$600. Kyle made a motion and Jolene seconded to get a new computer. All members voted 'aye'. Motion carried.

The council will pay 2/3 of the dust control on Elizabeth St for this year.

List of claims were presented for April. Justin made a motion and Kyle seconded to pay them. All members present voted 'aye'. Motion carried

Next meeting will be July 3, 2025.

There being no other known business before the council, Jolene made the motion to adjourn. Kyle seconded the motion. All members present voted 'aye'. Motion carried.
