Colin DeRuyter was here to get information regarding getting gravel for the repair of the alleys and lagoon road with the funds from FEMA.

The council is still working on getting the signs designed that will be placed on the highway.

The city council will go ahead with adopting the dangerous dog ordinance that the county passed. The ordinance will be formally adopted at the next meeting after giving residents a chance to look at the ordinance and respond if they want to.

The council reviewed the changes to the Personnel Policy. Kindel made a motion and Jolene seconded to approve the changes. All members present voted 'aye'. Motion carried.

Overdue water/sewer bills were reviewed. Letters will be sent out again.

The area in front of the city hall door will need to be redone after the tree removal. Cement will be placed there to help with snow removal.

List of claim was not available due to issues with the accounting program and the new computer upgrade.

Next meeting will be October 2, 2025.
