The Levan Town first CDBG public hearing was held on November 9, 2023, in the Levan Town Hall, 20 N Main, Levan, UT 84639, meeting commenced at 7:00 p.m.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Rowley opened the public hearing for the CDBG program and stated that the purpose of the public hearing is to provide citizens with pertinent information about the Community Development Block Grant program and to allow for discussion of possible applications for the **2024** funding cycle. It was explained that the grant money must be spent on projects benefiting primarily low and moderate-income persons. The **Six County Region**, in which **Levan Town** is a member, is expecting to receive approximately **\$850,000** in this new program year. All eligible activities that can be accomplished under this program are identified in the CDBG Application Policies and Procedures Manual and interested persons can review it at any time. **Mayor Rowley** read several of the eligible activities listed including examples, such as Construction of public works and facilities, e.g., water and sewer lines, fire stations, acquisition of real property, provision of public services such as food banks or homeless shelters. **Mayor Rowley** indicated that in the past **Levan Town** isn't aware of receiving CDBG funding. The Town has handed out its capital investment plan as part of the regional "Consolidated Plan". This list shows which projects the city has identified as being needed in the community. It was asked that anyone with questions, comments or suggestions during the hearing please identify themselves by name, before they speak. The clerk will include your names in the minutes, and we would like to specifically respond to your questions and suggestions during the hearing. There was no public comment.
