Chair Cathy Ward called the meeting to order at 8:03am. Committee members Donna Scattergood, Hope Bogenschutz, Sylvann Welcome, and Mike Repp were present along with 1 member of the public.

Scattergood moved, Repp second, to approve the agenda as posted. Carried 5-0

Scattergood moved, Repp second to approve the 7/11/2023 minutes as presented. Carried 5-0.

Public Input – None.

Mariner Park – Repp noted he sent a sketch of Mariner Park and the Val-A Property. Ward noted Ayres is working on a site plan for Mariner Park.

2024 Budget – Ward noted the Finance Committee has met twice and there have been no significant changes.

Disc Golf – Ward reported Jay is waiting for the Disc Golf group to mark the basket locations.

Boat Washing Station – Ward noted there are grants available and the Town should be ready to apply in 2024 for Mariner Park or the Marina.

Wind Phone Request – Ward noted her concern that the phone could be disrespected. Isle View may be a better location and more information regarding maintenance was requested for the next meeting. Mike Repp left at 8:36am.

Dogs in Town Parks – Ward noted a citizen expressed concern about unleashed aggressive dogs at Sand Bay and Hotz Parks. Myles Dannhausen, County ZZ, noted the committee may need to understand how large the problem is before changing policy. **Ward moved, Scattergood second** to eliminate “no dogs in park” from the current signs at Sand Bay, Ellison Bay, and Hotz Park to follow the current ordinance 8-23 which allows them in the parks but not swim/beach areas. Carried 4-0.

Correspondence – Ward noted the appreciation she receives from the public when she is at Town parks.

The next meetings will be 10/10/23, 11/14/23 and 12/12/23 at 8:00am.

Scattergood moved, Welcome second to adjourn at 8:52am. Carried 4-0.
