Chairman Ward called the meeting to order at 9:01am. Committee members Mike Ward and Hope Bogenshutz were present along with Clerk/Treasurer Pamela Donart-Welcome, and 5 members of the public. Sylvann Welcome was excused absent.

Repp moved, Bogenshutz seconded to approve the agenda as posted. **Carried 3 - 0**

Repp moved, Ward seconded to approve the 4/9/24 minutes as presented. **Carried 3 – 0**

Public input: Kent Schaefer of 1292 Garrett Bay Rd inquired about the status of the boat/kayak launch area at Garrett Bay, since he presented safety improvement ideas last year including removal of the concrete and asphalt. Mickie Rasch noted the property around the Welcome Center is being cleaned up, and to know where to place the brush that has been collected.

Ward noted the **disc golf course** people have made contact with the Town park crew, and the project is moving forward. The **wind phone** is built, and ready to be installed at Porte des Morts Park. The Town continues to work on redoing a Phase I, and having a Phase II environmental study done, and finalizing design plans at **Mariner Park**. It has been decided not to install a boat-cleaning station at Mariner park at this time. Bogenshutz has been working with the Google maps platform to keep our **Town parks** up-to-date for visitors, and help the Town understand frequency of use.

Ward noted that instead of installing a **boat cleaning station**, we could possibly consider a posting for a free “Check-In, Check-Out” educational program and Web app that educates folks about the impact of invasive species and encourage them to self-clean their boats to manage the spread.

Correspondence: Donart-Welcome reminded there will be Little League games taking place at Fitzgerald Park this season.
