Chairman Ward called the meeting to order at 9:00am. Committee members Paul Schwengel, Sylvann Welcome, Mike Repp, and Dan Warmbrodt were present along with Clerk/Treasurer Pamela Donart-Welcome, Administrator Lee Buckingham, and one member of the public.

Schwengel moved, Welcome seconded to approve the agenda as posted. **Carried 5 – 0**

Ward moved, Repp seconded to approve the minutes from 1/13/26 as presented. **Carried 5 – 0**

Public input: Chris Fye of 12530 Cedar Dell Ln asked for an update on the Garrett Bay launch area and told the Committee members that he does not want any poles installed on the launch area. He also reiterated his desire to have the large boulder rocks returned as they were before the launch area was improved. Cathy Ward informed the Committee of the changes made by the Wisconsin State Assembly to the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship program. Dan Warmbrodt reminded the Committee that the signs at Europe Bay still needed to be updated to eliminate the “No Dogs Allowed” on the large Town Park sign.

The Committee members decided to postpone both the discussion on a possible barrier to prevent vehicle traffic from driving across the lawn at Mariner Park, and the Vibrant Spaces Grant until a future meeting.

There was brief discussion on the possibility of installing poles at the Garrett Bay launch area. **Ward moved, Welcome seconded** that the Parks & Property Committee request that the Town Crew place some of the large rocks currently at Garrett Bay in a manner to facilitate swimmers’

access to the water from the shore. **Carried 5 - 0**

The Clerk notified the committee that the Town Maintenance Crew have been working on mounting the disc golf baskets onto concrete bases in the shop during the Winter months, so they can be placed onto the course in the Spring. The Committee members will discuss whether to refurbish the basketball court at Fitzgerald Park or explore installing pickle-ball courts at a future meeting. Further discussion on how much more detail needs to be included in the update of the Town's CORP (Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan) will take place at a future meeting. The Committee will work on updating the Town Parks brochure to incorporate new pictures and a new Liberty Grove Town Parks map at their next meeting.
