Meeting called to order – 7:03 pm

Approval of Minutes of the Tuesday, May 26th Meeting – Approved unanimously

Old Business :

Junk Car Ordinance: The proposed ordinance has been submitted to the Town Council as GCR 2026-01.

Peddler Ordinance: Jim reviewed the existing code provisions on peddlers. After discussion, the Committee agreed on several recommended amendments to the code. (1) Section 111.02 requires that peddler licenses “be signed by the President of the Town Council and countersigned by the Clerk-Treasurer.” The Committee recommends that this be changed so that licenses be signed by the Town Marshal instead of the Council President. (2) The Committee recommended restricting the hours in which soliciting may occur to daylight hours only and under no circumstances earlier than 10 am or later than 7 pm. (3) The Committee recommends that peddlers have to present a valid license or state identification to receive a permit from the Marshal. (4) The Committee recommended increasing permit fees to \$200 per month, \$300 for six months, and \$400 per year. (5) The Committee recommended increasing the penalties for peddling violations to \$250 (and \$350 after five days and adding a provision permitting revoking a license for violations. The Committee also raised questions about food trucks but concluded separate ordinances deal with them. Jim plans to put all recommended changes together and submit to the Town Council as a proposed ordinance.

Prior Recommendations: The Council previously recommended that Shore Drive speed bumps be reinstalled this summer. To date they have not been installed. Given how far we are into summer and the storms that have taken up so much Street Department time, it seems unlikely they will be installed this year. The Committee still unanimously recommends that speed bumps be installed this year. The GRC also plans to work on an ordinance at its next meeting regarding speed bumps.

The Council has under advisement but has taken no action on the following additional prior recommendations:

- (1) Staggered terms for committees, (2) Three-year committee member terms (mostly set up this way already); (3) 3-7 members per committee (mostly set up this way already); (4) Elimination of existing two term limit

Town Council Meetings: Rich and Eric have volunteered to attend the next meeting. GCR Members are reminded to attend when possible.

New Business

Storms: Doug is hoping to get funding to put power lines below ground.
