Community Crossings Road Repaving Grant Process vote to accept contractor bid

- The Council met to hear Street dept liaison, John Hannon's recommendation to choose the lowest responsive bid. 3 different contractors submitted competitive proposals to repave portions of 9 roads. These bids were made by-- Rieth Riley, Hamady Services and Milestone Contractors and opened during the June 1st council meeting. The lowest bidder was Hamady—but there was an error in their computation of paving material quantities. This led to an incorrect total cost—hence, John along with Mike Lanovich determined it to be a non-responsive bid. This meant that Milestone had the low bid. Their total amount is: **\$405,424.50**.
- Because the award process by INDOT is a bit different this year/cycle, it was important that council expedite their decision- so that clerk treasurer could formally submit documentation to INDOT for agency approval. In previous cycles, we would've already been granted the funds based on our application. The council would have then voted to directly award the job to Milestone.
- This time-- with approval by the agency, OD was preliminarily awarded a maximum amount of **\$339,129.00** on June 16th. Part of a town's grant eligibility is a commitment to locally fund 20% of the total project—which OD is able to. do.
- John made a motion to accept Milestone's project proposal as the lowest responsive bid and to authorize Amy to submit the council's recommendation letter to INDOT. Scott seconded. **ROLL CALL:** John Hannon—yes, Scott Kingan—yes, Doug Cannon—yes, Dave Snyder—yes, Bernadette Slawinski—yes. Motion passed.

Discussion of Project 1 -including additional paving of west end of Shore Dr.

- Doug asked whether this currently unpaved portion was eligible under CCMG rules? John responded that if this portion is *within the public right-of-way*, he believes it's eligible. He'll check if Mike included this in the Town's project specs.

Motion to adjourn made by Dave, seconded by Doug. Roll Call: Dave—yes, Doug—yes, John—yes, Scott—yes, Bernadette—yes. Meeting adjourned.
