EZ Beach Steps

- Fundraising – Access 9
- Access 7 and 9 installations
 - Access 9 went in as planned
 - Access 7 had the beautiful woodwork at the top that we retained. The actual steps were removed. They are on the beach. CJ, will you get those off the beach, please. The wood steps were replaced with the new steps. It is as close to perfect as we can get.
- Access 16 needs to have the vegetation removed or at least cut down on Town property near the wall. Can we do that? Can we put down some sort of pavers so it doesn't grow back?
- The sand fences along the south side of the wall need to be removed. They are metal stakes and plastic woven material. They will not disintegrate. The plastic is being buried and the stakes are in the way of the accessway. I will contact the homeowners down there. Was the fencing approved by the town.
- The vegetation has overgrown the access walkway. We need to ask ODHA to get that trimmed back.
- The new steps for 16 will arrive in 3-4 weeks. I would like to collect an additional \$4000 to pay for them. Any ideas?
