Water bill payments may be placed in the silver drop box located at the Village Hall right next to the U.S. Postal mailbox, in person during our office hours listed above or mail to us. Methods of payment are cash, check or money order. You may also pay online through our website at [rockdaleillinois.org](https://rockdaleillinois.org) by using your account number to pull up your bill.

Yard Waste pickup is on Mondays by our Public Works Department unless it's a holiday, then it will be picked up the next business day and is from April through the end of November. Acceptable yard waste must be in a 30 gal paper bag. (5) Bags can be set out for pick up no sooner than 2 days prior to pick up.

Branches and twigs must be bundled and tied approximately 30 lbs and 3 ft long bundles.

Recycling is done at the Village Hall by placing the recyclables in the large recycling container located on the east side of the lot. It is emptied on Tuesdays and Fridays each week.

Property Maintenance. Owners and occupants are responsible for maintenance, upkeep and repair of the property. Grass and weeds should not exceed 8”.

Building Permits: When are they required? Generally, you need to obtain a building permit from the Village whenever you construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, remove, improve, convert, or demolish a building or other structure. Burning is permitted from October 1 to December 1.

Joliet Township Animal Control terminated our Intergovernmental Agreement for strays and wildlife. Village residents can google search to find a wildlife/critter removal agency. The Village has a contract with Wags 2 Wellness for lost and found strays or pets. They can be reached at 888 526 9247 or 949 Bell Road, Minooka, IL 60447.

Dogs cannot run at large and must be on a leash. They also need to where ID tag stating the name, address and phone number of the owner and a rabies tag.

Parking on street after 2” of snowfall. After 2” of snowfall, parking is allowed on even sides of the street on even calendar days and odd sides of the street on odd calendar days.
