Should a village response be asked, The Village Board of Trustees may offer explanation or information to the public at that time. They also reserve the right to request the individual leave contact information with the Clerk to receive a more researched answer at a later time.
- 7. Individuals requesting response from the village board, not offered during the meeting, will be contacted by phone, email, letter, or request for in-person meeting.
- 8. All remarks shall be addressed to the board as a body and not to any individual member thereof.
- 9. Interested parties or their representatives may address the board at any time by written or electronic communications.
- 10. Speakers shall observe the commonly accepted rules of courtesy, decorum, dignity and good taste.
- 11. Village Board members are offered a 5-minute grace period for meeting start. If board member is more than 5 minutes late to the meeting, they will forfeit their right to participate and vote during the meeting.
- 12. While electronic devices are necessary for viewing documents and time keeping, as a courtesy to the public and fellow board members, Village Board Members must refrain from texting, e-mailing, and instant messaging during Board Meetings, except in the case of family emergencies.

WHEREAS, the Village of Saranac Lake allocated funds for sidewalk improvements and related expenditures during the 2025 fiscal year, and,

WHEREAS, not all the allocated funds are projected to be expended by the end of the fiscal year, and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village to preserve these unspent funds, totaling \$126,813.75, for future sidewalk projects.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of Trustees hereby directs the Village Treasurer to transfer the remaining balance of \$126,813.75 from the Sidewalks budget line (001-5410-0400-0000) for Fiscal Year 2025 to the Sidewalk Reserve Fund (001-0000-0230-5410) as of the close of the fiscal year. These funds shall remain in the Sidewalk Reserve Fund and shall be designated exclusively for future sidewalk-related projects, improvements, or maintenance, subject to future appropriation by the Village Board.

AUTHORIZING FUNDS TO REPAIR THE STAIRS AND THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF AN ACCESSIBILITY RAMP AT THE SARANAC LAKE POLICE STATION

WHEREAS, the Village of Saranac Lake is committed to ensuring equal access to municipal services, facilities, and buildings for all residents and visitors, regardless of physical ability; and

WHEREAS, the Village previously adopted the "Access to Everyone" initiative and has taken steps to assess and improve accessibility at multiple municipal parks and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Saranac Lake Police Department, now operating out of the former National Guard Armory, serves as a critical point of contact for public safety, emergency services, and community support; and

WHEREAS, the current main entrance to the police station is not ADA-accessible, creating a barrier for individuals with mobility impairments and limiting their access to police services; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief and members of the Saranac Lake Police Department, alongside the Department of Public Works and the Village Manager, have dedicated time and effort—often outside of regular hours—to physically relocate the department, set up necessary infrastructure, refresh interior spaces, meet incoming deliveries, and make key improvements to the new facility; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board acknowledges that continued improvement is necessary to align our facilities with the values and needs of the community we serve;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of Trustees hereby reaffirms its commitment to accessibility, equity, and the fair treatment of all residents; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Board authorizes the allocation of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) from the contingency fund (001-1990-0400) reasonably allocated to the following three accounts 001-3120-0200, 001-3120-0401, 001-3120-0400 to support the repairs to the stairs, purchase and installation of an ADA-compliant accessibility ramp at the main entrance of the Saranac Lake Police Station; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Village staff shall coordinate with appropriate contractors and vendors to ensure the timely and compliant installation of said accessibility improvements.

WHEREAS access to Village services is essential for all Village residents, and all individuals should have equal access to public safety, emergency services, or social assistance without fear; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Saranac Lake and the Saranac Lake Police Department is committed to providing the same opportunities, resources, and treatment to everyone, regardless of their background, characteristics, or beliefs, ensuring that everyone is treated in a just and unbiased manner, free from prejudice.

WHEREAS, the resources of the Village of Saranac Lake are finite, and the funding of Village services through local property taxes is an issue of extraordinary concern; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Government is best suited, and required by law, to enforce federal immigration laws;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Village of Saranac Lake Board of Trustees assures its residents that we will not tolerate acts of hate, discrimination, or harassment against any individual of our community; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Members of the Saranac Lake Village Police Department will not use village or department resources—including monies, facilities, property, equipment, or personnel—to investigate, enforce, or assist in the investigation or enforcement of any federal program based solely on actual or perceived immigration status; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village of Saranac Lake Police Department shall not inquire about the immigration status of an individual, including a crime victim, a witness, or a person who calls or approaches the police seeking help, unless necessary to investigate criminal activity by that individual; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village of Saranac Lake Police Department and its officers shall not stop, question, interrogate, investigate, or arrest an individual based solely on any of the following:

- Actual or suspected immigration or citizenship status; or
- Any actual or suspected civil violation of federal immigration laws;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village of Saranac Lake Police Department and its officers shall not perform or support the functions of a federal civil immigration officer or otherwise engage in the enforcement of federal civil immigration law; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Village of Saranac Lake reaffirms its commitment to ensuring that all individuals, regardless of immigration status, have safe and equal access to

public safety, emergency services, and social resources without fear of discrimination, harassment, or detention based solely on their immigration status.
