Consider and Discuss Canvassing the May 2, 2026 General Election:

Canvassing the May 2, 2026 election where Jason White ran unopposed and is re-elected. There were 326 total ballots cast, 8 absentee voting ballots cast, 219 early voting ballots cast, and 99 election day voting ballots cast. There are 2,314 registered voters and the turnout percentage was 14.09%. Election results for Alderman Place 1 are as follows: Ashley Carr received 265 votes and McKenzie Braddock received 59 votes. Election results for Alderman Place 5 are as follows: Todd Howell received 29 votes and Troy White received 294 votes. Alderman Cody made the motion to canvass the General Election and accept the results as presented. Alderman Waltisperger made the second. The motion carried with 4 in favor and Alderman T. White absent.

Consider and discuss Water/Sewer updates-Parkhill:

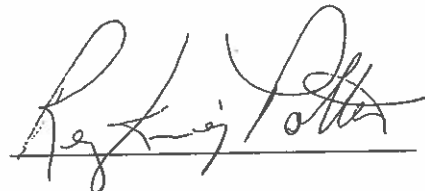
