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Earlier this month the committee recommended Stantec be offered both the engineering and the construction services contracts. The DOT explained Stantec cannot perform the construction services because their name was on the grant application; had their QBS actually been from their partner, KL Engineering, it could have been approved, but since it showed Stantec as the primary, it cannot be approved. As such we need to select a new company for construction services (you could also select a different company for engineering, but it is my understanding you wanted to work with Stantec on the engineering).

Just a reminder, the DOT has the final say on who gets awarded the construction services contract.
