D.L. Gasser Construction double seal North and South end of parking lot for \$7650,
remove old black top or grind at the intersection of Cypress and 20th Ave, add 6in of
gravel compacted and sealed or 2in mat for \$24,945.00, wedge with paver, patch and
crack fill as needed on 20th Ave from south of bridge to Cumberland Ave for \$26,815.00,
wedge with paver, patch and crack fill 20th Ave from Cumberland Ave to Hwy 21 for
\$21,948.00, and wedge and seal 17th ave from Cumberland S. to Cypress for \$12,567.00.
Fahrner Asphalt Sealers LLC to crack fill and seal the parking lot in front of Town Hall
for \$4,640.00. M/C
