Special Town Board Meeting Minutes

October 24, 2023, 1:00 PM

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. and led in the pledge of allegiance. In attendance were Supervisors Jim Lowrey and Jeff Notstad, Clerk Carissa Lyle, Public Works Director George Waag, Public Works Employee Steve Brandt, GFL Representative Jason Johnson, and Janice Redford of the community. Chair Mark Cook was absent.

PROCEDURAL

NEW BUSINESS

- a. Discussion/possible action regarding GFL trash bins.

GFL Rep, Jason Johnson discussed manual pick-up, we are the only community GFL provides service to that still does manual pick-up. In order to be more efficient and safer GFL has moved to using carts only for pick-up. He apologized for the poor communication from GFL in rolling the new carts out. GFL will still continue to pick up bulk items, but would like to move to just the one trash cart and no bags or multiple carts. Residents can move to a 2 yd farm dumpster if they believe they will have more trash to collect than will fit in one cart. Residents can reach out to GFL to set this up. Any residents who have the smaller 65-gallon cart can call GFL to replace it with the larger 96-gallon cart for no cost.

- b. Discussion/possible action regarding re-appointing Dawn Redford to the Plan Commission.

Jeff Notstad moved to re-appoint Dawn Redford for a one-year term to the Plan Commission. Jim Lowrey seconded the motion.
