

ORDINANCE CONTROLLING DEDICATION OF PUBLIC ROADS IN THE TOWN OF NEW HOPE

The Town Board of the Town of New Hope, Portage County, Wisconsin do ordain the following:

No road, street or way of travel shall be dedicated, donated or granted to the Town, either within a subdivision or without, unless the same is in compliance with the provisions hereinafter set forth. The Town Board may, but shall not be required to waive all or a part of the requirements hereinafter following.

STREET IMPROVEMENTS. All roads, streets and public ways shall be graded to their full width, including side slopes, and to the appropriate subgrade, and the travelled roadway thirty-two (32) feet in width shall be surfaced with a minimum of four (4) inches of road gravel, and the traveled roadway twenty two (22) feet in width shall be surfaced with either three (3) inches of a cold-mix or six (6) inches of road gravel, all in accordance with applicable specifications of the Town. Said blacktopping shall not be applied to the streets until such time as the four (4) inches of road gravel has laid on the proposed street for a period of one (1) winter season (December 15 to May 31). Such construction shall be subject to the inspection and approval by the Town Board.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS. In addition to the above requirements, all roads, streets and public ways shall be constructed pursuant to the provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and any other lawful governing authority.

PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation who fails to comply with any provision of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), together with the cost of prosecution for each violation. Each day a violation exists or continues shall constitute a separate offense.

CONSTRUCTION AND EFFECTIVE DATE. The provisions of this ordinance shall be applicable to all roads, streets, and ways of travel dedicated to the Town after the effective date of this ordinance. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
