

TOWN OF BARTON
ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, APRIL 19, 2022

Notice of this meeting was given to the public by posting on the municipal boards and by posting on Town Website: townofbarton.net.

1. Call to Order, Affidavit of Posting.
Chairman Kris Turner called the Annual Town Meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Affidavit of posting was read.
2. Pledge of Allegiance and attendance.
Those in attendance were Supervisors Mike Dricken, Bill Russell, and Clayton Eggie. Treasurer Jennifer Lenzendorf, Zoning Administrator, Steve Wendelborn, Clerk Sherry Eckert and six concerned citizens. Supervisor, Dan Mueller was excused. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by those present.
3. Supervisor Dricken made a motion to approve the Minutes of the April 20, 2021 Annual Town Meeting. Supervisor Russell seconded. Motion carried, unanimous.
4. Oath of Office had been administered to newly elected officers prior to annual meeting.
5. Chairman Turner reported that in 2021 road work was performed on Beaver Dam Road, a culvert was replaced on Wildwood Road. \$50,000 was recorded as an entry separated for snowplow replacement. Repairs performed by supervisors to transfer station which now allows for a 42-yard container. The Town Hall received new siding and areas of rotting were taken care of. Outdoor electric outlets were added. New Concrete sidewalk was put in at Town Hall and Woodford Bridge received new boards. No issues with chipping. The salt shed is full.
6. Maintenance to the Town equipment has been ongoing and discussion on the sale and purchase of snow plows will be discussed in Town Board meeting following the Annual Meeting.
