

Special Budget Meeting – November 14, 2024

Chairman, Wilmer Geiser called the public hearing to order at 7:00PM on the proposed budget.

After some discussion the public hearing was closed and the special town meeting of the electors continued on the proposed budget.

No additional town electors were present so the members of the town board stepped down to vote as electors on the 2024 town tax levy. All 4 voted to approve the 2024 Municipal Levy Limit of \$170,311.

Shane Peik made a motion that was second by Don Bonlander to set the chairman salary to \$6,000 and the supervisor's salary to \$3,500 for the upcoming term. Motion carried.

After voting on the 2024 levy limit the meeting continued with the special town board meeting to discuss and adopt the proposed 2025 budget. Shane Peik made a motion that was second by Don Bonlander to add an additional \$10,000 to the budget for Sealcoat and wedging, a \$20,000 designation to the machinery fund and a \$10,000 designation to the bridge fund and then approve the proposed 2025 budget, including the tax levy of \$170,311. Motion Carried.

Shane Peik made a motion that was second by Don Bonlander to adjourn at 7:40PM. Motion carried
