

Town Board Meeting Minutes
Monday, January 12, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Huber. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. December 15, 2025 meeting minutes were read by Keller. Motion to approve by Doane, 2nd by Bocek. Motion passes. The Treasurer's report was given by Keller. Motion to approve by Doane, 2nd by Bocek. Motion passes. Review and payment of bills. Doane motion to approve with the exception of the 2 invoices from the Crandon Fire Department for the car accidents. Motion passes. The February meeting will be changed from February 9th to the 16th due to the clerk being on vacation. The DOT approved the change of scope for the Local Road Improvement Plan on Old 8 Road. All the paperwork was submitted for reimbursement of \$32,000.00. We were approved \$29,000.00 for the upcoming project on Kemp Lane. The road report was given by Wyatt. Sam Kalata has not been able to take down the trees on White Eye Lake Road yet. John will reach out to him. Ison Road is being plowed and sanded by Flannery Contracting. Under public comment, there were questions regarding the garbage charge and residents who are being charged twice when adjacent parcel only has a barn or shed. Motion by Doane that the Board has the discretion to waive the garbage fee of residents who are being charged multiple times for adjacent properties that do not have buildings that are being occupied. Motion 2nd by Huber, motion passes. Huber has an appointment with MSA to talk with a grant writer. The question was asked if land is put in "Indian Trust" will we stop getting taxes for it. Keller will reach out to the Town's Association to get more information. Discussion was held on if a lean to could be added to the side of the building for equipment. Due to the septic being in that area, we can not construct anything there. Motion by Huber to enter into closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 19.85 (1)(c) for considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee. Motion 2nd by Doane. The board entered into closed session. Motion by Doane and 2nd by Bocek to return to open session. No action was taken. Motion by Bocek to adjourn, 2nd by Doane. The meeting adjourned.
