

Town Board Meeting Minutes
Monday, April 13, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Huber. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The March 9, 2026 meeting minutes were read by Keller. Motion to approve by Doan, 2nd by Bocek. Motion passes. The Treasurer's report was given by Keller. Motion to approve by Doane, 2nd by Bocek. Motion passes. Review and payment of bills. Doane motion to approve, 2nd Bocek, motion passes. The 1st quarter budget report was available for residents to look at. The assessor's contract with Childers Appraisals, LLC was presented. The contract is for a period of 5 assessment years, 2027-2031. Motion by Bocek and 2nd by Doane to approve the contract. Motion passes. The town must be audited for 2025 and all years going forward because of our combination clerk/treasurer position. Kerber-Rose submitted a contract for services not to exceed \$10,900.00 for the 2025 audit. Kerber-Rose already completes our yearly CT Financial Form for the Department of Revenue. The Clerk submitted a request to attend Clerk College class that are being offered by the Wisconsin Town's Association. The cost is \$599.00. Motion by Doane to approve, 2nd by Bocek. Motion approved. The town will be accepting bids for the Town Cemetery. Bids are due by Friday, May 8, 2026. Residents of the trailer park who are delinquent on their trailer park fees will be billed with interest each month. A record will be kept of those delinquent on payment. Guests from MSA spoke regarding grant writing for town road improvements. There are different types of grants; ARIP, TRIS, TRID, and culvert/bridge programs. The next round will start in October of 2027. MSA will work with us to prepare grants we may be eligible for. The road report was given by Wyatt. Lots of water on Bocek Rd. May use recycled blacktop to build up the washouts. Under public comment: Hollywood Hill turned in their liquor license applications. Some will need to be corrected on the state website.
