

Town Board Meeting Minutes
Monday, June 8, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Huber. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. The May 11, 2026 meeting minutes were read by Keller. Motion to approve by Doane, 2nd by Bocek. Motion passes. The Treasurer's report was given by Keller. Motion to approve by Doane, 2nd by Bocek. Motion passes. Review and payment of bills. Doane motion to approve, 2nd Bocek, motion passes. Wyatt has resigned from his road job. We will post the job for 3 weeks. Nick Crum will fill in for now. Motion by Bocek and 2nd by Huber to pay Nick \$30.00 per hour. Motion passes. There was a driveway permit requested for Lot 1 on Sipple Road. The area was checked out and a driveway permit will be issued for the buyer to complete and return to us. Resolution 2026-01 was presented and will include a fine of \$500.00 for each offense and will pay the cost of any road repair. Motion by Bocek and 2nd by Doane to approve. Motion passes. The resolution will be published in the paper. Motion by Huber and 2nd by Bocek to approve liquor licenses for the following: Holly Wood Hill Event Center, LLC, Wolf River Rendezvous, Crandon Motorsports, and Beaches Steaks & Spirits. Doane abstained, Motion passes. LRIP bids were opened. Pitlick & Wick - \$76,815.00. North East Asphalt \$63,799.65 and a proposal from the Forest County Highway Department for \$64,500.00. Motion by Doane to accept the bid from North East Asphalt. 2nd by Bocek. Motion passes. Will ask if the price will be the same if the road is extended a little longer. Rick will notify the bidders. Under public comment, the clean up day went well. It was suggested to possibly have 2 days per year. It was also suggested that we may need to increase the pay for our road workers to attract more applicants. Motion to adjourn by Huber and 2nd by Doane. Meeting was adjourned.
