

Town of Daniels Fall Road Tour Meeting

September 16, 2023

Meeting called to order at 8:00 A.M. by Chairman Mike Huber. Members Bob Viltz and Mike Hoefs, road maintenance employee Jim Kolander.

Road Maintenance: Board had a lengthy discussion on remaining items to be completed yet in 2023 season. Reviewed items Mike had pointed out at September regular board meeting and determined items needed to be completed before winter. Items included shouldering Spangberg Rd., installing new culverts on Range Line and Church Rd., striping parking lots at Lindberg Park and town hall, and also paying Monarch their remaining bill for work completed in 2023. Total will be around \$100,000.00 to complete work. Mike Hoefs made a motion to move forward with completing the list of work and Bob seconded the motion. The vote passed 3-0.

Then discussed financing options and agreed to start exploring options that will be discussed at the October town meeting. Mike Hoefs made a motion to borrow up to \$100,000.00 for a 1-year term and Bob seconded the motion. The vote was 3-0 to approve.

Road Tour: We then toured roads where work would be completed and measured and discussed culvert replacement. Also drove down to Elbow Lake Rd and discussed the possibility of entering this road for upcoming TRIP Funding.

Mike will be updating CIP for the next five years.

Jim has been working on patching potholes and completed some brush mowing.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 A.M.
