

Regular Town Board Meeting

Supervisor Mike Hoefs called to order the Regular Town Board Meeting with Supervisor Bob Viltz, Clerk Liz Simonsen, Treasurer Kandy Unger and maintenance employee Jim Kolander present. Mike Huber joined the meeting by phone.

**Pledge of Allegiance** was recited at the Caucus Meeting.

**Public Comments:** Chairman Mike Huber thanked all Town Board members for all their hard work to accomplish a successful and productive year in 2024.

**Road Report:** Mike Huber talked to the Town Board about compiling a spreadsheet to track Highway expenses for winter maintenance, summer maintenance, etc. to better plan how much money is left in Budget for future projects. Jim Kolander is mowing road right away since there is no snow. It was suggested to mow around culverts and bridges when possible. Mike Hoefs asked about receiving money from Burnett Co Highway Dept for inventory of bridges he took in Town of Daniels. He invoiced the St of Wi and money will flow through the County to pay Town for his work.

**Siren Fire Association Report:** Meeting was on January 6, 2025. Bob Viltz reported that they continue to work on draft of policies instead of changing the municipal agreement entered into by all 4 municipalities. He shared the reports at the meeting.

**Cemetery Report: Motion** was made by Mike Hoefs and seconded by Bob Viltz to approve the sale of plot K2F-4 to Lonny and Terry Pearson. Motion carried. The Board discussed some of the cemetery policies as a request was made to waive burial fee and place remains by private party. This is not allowed in the Cemetery.
