

Regular Town Board Meeting

Tuesday, May 12, 2026

Following Board of Review which began at 7:00 p.m.

Supervisor Mike Huber called to order the Regular Town Board Meeting with Supervisor Bob Viltz, Supervisor Mike Hoefs, Clerk Liz Simonsen, Treasurer Kandy Unger, maintenance employee Jim Kolander, Burnett Co Supervisor Chuck Awe, 1 resident and 3 nonresidents present.

**Pledge of Allegiance** was recited

**Public Comments:** Complaint received from party that neighbor is playing loud music. They will be advised to call Burnett Co Sheriff's Department.

**Agenda: Motion** made by Mike Hoefs and seconded by Bob Viltz to approve the agenda with the addition of WTA meeting report. Motion carried.

**Opening of Road Maintenance Bids and Estimates:** Bids/estimates were received from Monarch Paving, Madison Pulverizing, Fahrner Asphalt, Hopkins Sand & Gravel, Seal Tech and Burnett Co Highway Dept. List attached.

**Chairman Report:** Mike Huber is working on driveway permit for Matson family.

**Burnett Co Report:** Chuck Awe summarized committee meetings and stated that a new hangar at airport is being built. Minutes from Burnett Co are on their Website.

**Regular Town Board Meeting: Motion** made by Mike Hoefs and seconded by Bob Viltz to approve the Regular Town Board Meeting minutes of April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Motion carried.

**Annual Town Elector Meeting: Motion** by Bob Viltz and seconded by Mike Hoefs to approve the Annual Meeting minutes of April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report: Motion** made by Mike Huber and seconded by Bob Viltz to accept the Treasurer's Report. Motion carried.

**Road Report:** The LSSIP (local small structures improvement program) application was sent on April 29<sup>th</sup>. The Town of Siren has been helping Jim Kolander with filling the potholes with hot mixture on town roads. The gravel is applied on Blomberg Rd and is ready for paving. **Motion** made by Mike Huber and seconded by Mike Hoefs to purchase 2 rear tires for the Backhoe. Motion carried. **Motion** made by Mike Hoefs and seconded by Bob Viltz to accept the quote from Seal Tech for crackfilling and polypatching. Motion carried. **Motion** made by Mike Hoefs and seconded by Mike Huber to accept the bid of Hot Mix 83.32 for a total of \$299,952 for paving of Blomberg Rd. Motion carried with 2 ayes and 1 nay.

**Mudhen Lake Rehabilitation Meeting:** Board of Commissioners virtual meeting was on April 28<sup>th</sup>. Mike Hoefs reported they are continuing to discuss organization and issues with invasive management. Asked how tax levy is collected and paid to them.

**Wi Towns Association:** Meeting was April 23<sup>rd</sup>. Bob Viltz gave a report on meeting. North Memorial Ambulance contract will be due for renewal and a committee was formed to review terms. Reports at the meeting were given by local authorities.

**Cemetery Report:** Lee Helene is mowing the cemetery, park and town hall.

**Town Hall/Shop/Park Report:** The bathrooms at the park need to be maintained. It was suggested that Raska be called asap to clean and maintain bathrooms again this year.

**Highway Maintenance Wages:** Motion was made by Bob Viltz and seconded by Mike Huber to approve a 15% raise in wages for Jim Kolander starting now. Motion carried.
