

Special Town Board and Road Tour Meeting  
Saturday, March 21, 2026  
Daniels Town Hall

Town Chairman called the Special Town Board Meeting to order with Supervisor Mike Hoefs, Supervisor Bob Viltz, Clerk Liz Simonsen, Treasurer Kandy Unger and maintenance employee Jim Kolander present.

**Agenda: Motion** made by Mike Hoefs and seconded by Bob Viltz to approve the Agenda. Motion carried.

**Liquor License Report:** Liz Simonsen reported she received a call on Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026 from WI Dept of Revenue's Alcohol Special Agent on site at Backwoods Beer and Bait. He stated that when he was reviewing their records an appointment of a special agent (Form 101) was not on file which is a requirement for a LLC. Also, when checking Joe Feit's ID, he was not a resident of WI, therefore a special agent needs to be appointed. Both requirements need to be satisfied with the proper paperwork before the Town of Daniels can reissue Backwoods Beer and Bait's Alcohol Beverage Licenses. The Town Board asked questions and viewed the incomplete paperwork received. The Town Clerk was asked to send a letter to Joe Feit listing the items that need to be completed before the April 21<sup>st</sup> Town Board meeting when action may be taken.

**Siren Fire Association Intermunicipal Coop Agreement:** Mike Huber shared an original agreement between the 4 Municipalities. He stated it looks like changes have been made before with no documentation showing amendments and signatures by Municipalities. The Town of Daniels Board took no action until further review with Siren Fire Association.

**LSSIP Discussion: Motion** by Mike Huber and seconded Bob Viltz to move forward with application and hire Mike Hoefs as engineer for project at a rate not to exceed State Statutes regarding contracts with Board Members. Motion carried with 2 ayes and 1 abstain. Discussion will resume On Site as part of Road Tour.

**Set Bid Opening for Blomgren Rd:** The Town Board discussed all the maintenance work planned for the 2026 season and to request bids for all work on April 6 with notices to the Inter County Leader, website and Town Hall. Bids will be due at noon on April 29, 2026 and opened at May 12, 2026 Regular Town Board Meeting.

**Equipment Needs:** Jim Kolander provided information on Truck Pricing. Also, the Town Board will look at prices for updating the Grader.

**Road Tour:** We went to Shearman Rd .site of the LSSIP and completed field measurements of the existing structure and discussed design issues for the project. Then drove 32 miles of road and discussed 2027 construction plans for Shuttleworth Rd., 2026 maintenance work and also discussed 2026 paving work on Blomgren RD. Huber will put together a bid document for the ad.

Daniels 70 was also discussed and we will wait on the project for now but will be in discussion with BCHD about future funding possibilities.
