

2026 ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

Tuesday, April 21, 2026

Daniels Town Hall at 7:00 p.m.

The 2026 Annual Town Meeting was called to order by Mike Huber. There were 10 residents and 1 non-resident in attendance. See attendance record attached. Notice posted in accordance to Wis.Stat.19.84 Open Meeting Law.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comments: Keith Mogel, candidate for the Assembly District 75 addressed those present of his candidacy and vision for District 75.

Review of the Annual Meeting Guidelines: Attendees referred to 2025 Minutes for the Annual Meeting Guidelines. **1.** The presiding officer will be the Town Chairman or appointed. **2.** Only qualified electors may vote, at least 18 years old and a resident in town for 28 days. Show of Hands chosen as voting method. **3.** Sec 60.13 of WI Stat. requires that parliamentary procedure be used. All actions of meeting shall be by vote. **4.** Only items that are listed in WI stat 60.10 can be acted on, all other items are advisory to Town Board. **5.** Actions become effective 30 days after posted. **6.** Minutes shall be prepared within 5 days of meeting and approved next year.

Motion made by Liz Simonsen and seconded by Kandy Unger to nominate Mike Huber as Chairman of the meeting and to vote by raise of hands. Motion carried by show of hands, 10 in favor, 1 abstain and 0 opposed.

Approval of 2025 Annual Meeting Minutes: **Motion** made by Teresa Stein and seconded by Mike Hoefs to approve the 2025 Annual Meeting minutes. Motion carried by show of hands, 10 in favor, 1 abstain and 0 opposed.

2025 Year in Review of Town: It was noted that the Town paid off the Siren Fire Association fire truck debt. Highway Budget was increased with \$150,000 loan and more roads are being maintained. Also noted was Town backhoe and Siren Fire Association fire hall will be paid off in 2026.

2025 Statement of Financial Condition Report: Written copies were provided by Town Clerk Liz Simonsen. She reviewed the financial report with those present and took questions from the floor.

Motion was made by Kandy Unger and seconded by Jim Kolander to accept the financial report as presented. Motion carried by show of hands, 10 in favor, 1 abstain and 0 opposed.

Long Range Road Plan: Mike Huber gave a report on how much more it costs to maintain roads and maintenance accomplished. Also stated was bidding is out for resurfacing Blomberg Rd and Shuttleworth Rd is on the list for maintenance and resurfacing next. The CIP report is for 10 years and is available to taxpayers.

Set date for Annual Town Meeting of 2027: No changes made from 2026. Annual Town meeting will be held on 3rd Tuesday of April per Wi Statue 60.11(2) (a). which is **Tuesday, April 19th, 2027 at 7:00 p.m.**

Any Other Business to be brought before the Town Electors: **Motion** made by Jim Kolander and seconded by Mike Stein to give the Town Board a 10% increase to salaries. Motion carried with 10 in favor, 1 abstain and 0 opposed. New salary amounts will take effect in April, 2027 after Town Board Election. **Motion** made by Teresa Stein and seconded by Mike Hoefs to give Jim Kolander a minimum of 10% raise. Motion carried by show of hands, 10 in favor, 1 abstain and 0 opposed. She stated he has done a fantastic job as road maintenance employee. This motion is advisory to Town Board.

Adjournment: With the business completed, Mike Huber adjourned the 2026 Annual Meeting.
