Regular Meeting Minutes November 11, 2025

In attendance: Dan Lilla, Chairman; David Kujak, Supervisor; David Kramer, Supervisor; Kara Wener, Clerk; Becky Tiedje, Treasurer, Ken Frahm, Jr., David Frahm, Charles Kulas, Rick Kujak, and Gordie Gibbons

Meeting called to order at 6:30. Chairman Lilla asked if public notice requirements were met for the meeting; Clerk Wener affirmed public notice requirements were met.

Supervisor Kujak made a motion to approve the prior month regular meeting minutes. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote, motion carried.

Public Comments: None

Road Maintenance and Future Road Projects: Chairman Lilla noted the following: shed is partially full of salt/sand mix and will be full after another load of sand is mixed; final mowing is complete. Supervisor Kramer noted a washout is developing on Pine Creek Ridge Road on the hill portion and is 18" deep. Rick Kujak, road worker, was authorized to fill the washout.

Fire Department By-laws and Update: No updates.

Dodge Sanitary District: Charles Kulas was given the floor and noted he is now certified in wastewater and has six more tests to complete to be fully certified in all necessary water/sewer capacities for the district.

Road issue on Jereczek Lane: Gordie Gibbons was given the floor. Mr. Gibbons expressed concern about a gouge in the Jereczek Lane that may cause problems in the future. Chairman Lilla noted it would be reviewed in the spring and repair made at that time.

Trempealeau County Overpayment of August Settlement: Treasurer Tiedje was given the floor. Tiedje noted, the county made a significant overpayment to the town for the August tax settlement, which must now be repaid to the county. The town wasn't alerted to the amount until November 2. Clerk Wener has communicated that the town will pay in two installments; one in November and one in December.

Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP): A number of road project options were discussed for the TRI (entitlement program with a 50/50 cost split not to exceed the amount available to the town's eligible for the program) and the TRIS (70/30 cost split).

Supervisor Kujak made motion to pursue the TRIS (70/30) grant for milling and reconstructing the full length of Glodowski Road and the TRI entitlement grant for a double chip seal coat on Pine Creek Ridge Road from the hill down for roughly 1 mile.

Review of Orders: Orders were reviewed in the meeting. Supervisor Kujak made a motion to approve orders for payment. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote. Motion carried.

Upcoming Meetings: The next regular meeting will be December 9 at 6:30pm.

Adjournment: Supervisor Kujak made motion to adjourn. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:47 pm.
