

Regular Meeting Minutes

February 10, 2026

In attendance: Dan Lilla, Chairman; David Kujak, Supervisor; David Kramer, Supervisor; Kara Wener, Clerk; Becky Tiedje, Treasurer, Ken Frahm, Jr., David Frahm, Charles Kulas, Rick Kujak

Meeting called to order at 6:30. Chairman Lilla asked if public notice requirements were met for the meeting; Clerk Wener affirmed public notice requirements were met.

Supervisor Kujak made a motion to approve the prior month regular meeting minutes. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote, motion carried.

Public Comments: Supervisor Kujak noted that there continues to be a pile of free stuff on the corner of Bambenek St and Cty Rd G. Questioned whether the town could request this be removed. Clerk Wener noted she will send a letter to the property owners requesting that no more items be placed in the yard as it poses a sightline hazard on the corner.

Road Maintenance and Future Road Projects: Chairman Lilla noted the following: the town was awarded the regular LRIP project and awaiting work on TRIS/TRID, County Rd P bridge project would like to place a mobile office near the town shop, and the board will need to consider whether to pursue insulation of the town shop. Chairman Lilla will obtain some quotes on full shed insulation vs. a single bay insulation.

Fire Department By-laws and Update: No update.

Dodge Sanitary District: Charles Kulas was given the floor and noted he completes the CMAR paperwork for the Dodge Sanitary District and would be willing to assist Pine Creek Sanitary District if needed.

Fee Schedule Discussion: Fees were reviewed and adjustments discussed. Clerk Wener was authorized to update the fees as discussed and share at the next meeting for further consideration.

Credit Card Policy: The credit card policy was discussed.

Supervisor Kujak made motion to adopt the credit card policy as written. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote, motion carried.

Consideration of amending or repealing Ordinance 2016-3 Beer License Quota: Clerk Wener noted when the limit was put in place event venues were exempt from needing a beer/wine license to operate. State law has since changed.

Supervisor Kujak made motion to repeal Ordinance 2016-3 Beer License Quota effective immediately. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote, motion carried.

WTA District Meeting: Chairman Lilla and Supervisor Kujak will attend the Friday, March 6 WTA district meeting in Onalaska. Clerk Wener was authorized to register the attendees.

Review of Orders: Orders were reviewed in the meeting. Supervisor Kujak made a motion to approve orders for payment. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote. Motion carried.
