

Regular Meeting Minutes

March 10, 2026

In attendance: Dan Lilla, Chairman; David Kujak, Supervisor; David Kramer, Supervisor; Kara Wener, Clerk; Becky Tiedje, Treasurer, Ken Frahm, Jr., David Frahm, Charles Kulas, Rick Kujak, Jacob Jones, and Jessie Bawek

Meeting called to order at 6:30. Chairman Lilla asked if public notice requirements were met for the meeting; Clerk Wener affirmed public notice requirements were met.

Supervisor Kujak made a motion to approve the prior month regular meeting minutes. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote, motion carried.

Public Comments:

Zoning and Parcel Split Request: Jacob Jones from Pearl and Pine Event Co. was given the floor. Mr. Jones shared his request for a parcel split to ensure access to a small business loan and a request to rezone the property at N19019 County Rd. G, Dodge, WI to allow for the building of an event space.

Supervisor Kujak made motion to support and approve the parcel split and the required rezone for building an event space. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote, motion carried.

Road Maintenance and Future Road Projects: Chairman Lilla noted the following: the road bans are on and LRIP bid notices will be prepared in coming weeks. TJ Fonfara asked if anything could be done about the dip near the bridge on Whistle Pass. Chairman Lilla noted it would be looked at during the road review.

Fire Department By-laws and Update: Fire Chief, TJ Fonfara was given the floor. Chief Fonfara noted the chicken-q fundraiser will be held on April 12. Work with Trempealeau County Sherrif continues to improve communication in Dodge with consideration of adding an antenna to a water tower. Jessie Bawek, Dodge First Responder, expressed interest in expanding the first responder territory into a portion of the town of Arcadia to ensure improved response times for neighboring portions of the Town of Arcadia. Jessie Bawek was authorized to inform the Town of Arcadia of this interest.

Dodge Sanitary District: No update.

Fee Schedule Discussion: Fees were reviewed and adjustments discussed. Clerk Wener was authorized to update the fees as discussed and share at the next meeting for further consideration.

2025 Financials: Treasurer Tiedje was given the floor. Treasurer showed the end of year financials and tied out to the statements from financial institutions.

Supervisor Kujak made motion to approve the 2025 financials as presented by Treasurer Tiedje. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote, motion carried.

Review of Orders: Orders were reviewed in the meeting. Supervisor Kujak made a motion to approve orders for payment. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote. Motion carried.
