

Regular Meeting Minutes

May 12, 2026

In attendance: Dan Lilla, Chairman; David Kujak, Supervisor; David Kramer, Supervisor; Kara Wener, Clerk; Becky Tiedje, Treasurer, Ken Frahm, Jr., David Frahm, Charles Kulas, Fred Hoesley

Meeting called to order at 6:30. Chairman Lilla asked if public notice requirements were met for the meeting; Clerk Wener affirmed public notice requirements were met.

Supervisor Kujak made a motion to approve the prior month regular meeting minutes. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote, motion carried.

Road Maintenance and Future Road Projects: Chairman Lilla noted road inspection was completed with a thorough review of the LRIP project sites, Old County Road J culvert issues, and approval of a driveway permit. Supervisor Kramer asked if the town should consider renting a boom tractor for large brush cutting and will look into pricing more closely. Supervisor Kramer noted the road worker questioned the rate for skid steer usage. Chairman Lilla will discuss with the road worker.

Fire Department By-laws and Update: Ken Frahm, fire department member, noted it has been quiet. Requested a letter on behalf of the first responders for acquiring a key for the Dodge Hillside apartments. Clerk Wener was authorized to prepare a letter.

Dodge Sanitary District: Charles Kulas, operator mentioned a DNR visit will occur in June.

Claim Against the Town: Chairman Lilla noted an insurance claim was filed against the Dodge Sanitary District and the Town of Dodge. Chairman Lilla made motion that the Town Board of the Town of Dodge formally disallow the claim submitted by Keith Michael Jereczek and filed with the Town on February 24, 2026, and direct the Town Clerk to provide written notice of disallowance as required by applicable law.

Seconded by Supervisor Kujak. Verbal vote, motion carried.

Review of Orders: Orders were reviewed in the meeting. Supervisor Kujak made a motion to approve orders for payment. Seconded by Supervisor Kramer. Verbal vote. Motion carried.

Correspondence: WTA meeting notice, Cochrane Telephone thought they had access to PSC funds, but the money was frozen federally.
