

Town of Doty
Monthly Board Meeting - Minutes February 10, 2026 – 7 p.m.

The Town Board meeting was called to order by Chairman Stemp at 7:00 pm in the Town Hall. Roll call was taken with Chairman Stemp, Supervisor Siewert, Supervisor Dryja, Clerk/Treasurer Field in attendance. There were (5) in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The agenda was posted on February 5, 2026. Clerk/Treasurer Field certifies that the open meeting law requirements have been met.

Order of the day - motion to approve agenda "order of the day", was made by Chairman Stemp, seconded by Supervisor Dryja, all were in favor.

Minutes of the Town Board Meeting from 1/13/2026, were reviewed and, Supervisor Siewert made motion, seconded by Supervisor Dryja, to approve all board minutes, all were in favor.

Library Report – Update was given by Chairman Stemp, Deb was excused. Updates included, solar is working well- saving money, and next community meeting is 2/25/26. No motions entertained.

MAS - Supervisor Siewert gave updated report; (25) calls, (1) in Doty. There were (4) no transports. Discussion included, 2024 heat issue update, 2017 exhaust issue, ambulance is still for sale, there were (2) new applicants, and the past due accounts issue is still being addressed. No motions at this time.

Cemetery report – Supervisor Dryja gave update. There is (1) pending spring burial. Not much to report. No motions made.

Fire Department Report/Qualification issues with NETC/PTSC/Approve auction of surplus vehicles – Fire Chief Charlier was excused. Chairman Stemp gave updates including, no calls for the month, but meetings and training were still on going. Update in regard to certifications vs company used/NWTC issue, and there was discussion in regard to the new to us rescue unit. Chairman Stemp then made motion to sell the (2) old vehicles (1995 Chevy C/K pickup with work body and the 1994 Ford E350 ambulance) via bids due by the March 10th, 2026 meeting time, seconded by Supervisor Siewert.

Humane officer report – Chairman Stemp gave update, discussed re-coup of expenses call on 1/22/2026. (x) pet call in Doty. No motions were entertained.

OCSO report – Chairman Stemp gave a brief update. There were (?) calls and (?) 911 hang up. Bond schedule, animal abuse/neglect charge – were among discussion points. No motions made at this time.

Road report / Purchase of used road grader = donation – Supervisor Siewert gave update. No motions made.

LUPC – Meeting held 10 am, February 10th, 2026 in regard to Rex Avenue Vacate happened, the next quarter = if needed, will be held May? 2026. See Rex Avenue Vacate agenda item for details. No motions entertained.

STR Report – Chairman Stemp gave update. Clerk/Treasurer Field gave update that Camp Lake Resort continues to be in compliance with rules, and that yearly permit fee of \$50 was foregone this time in recognition of that. Steve and Kristy Walker paid for their 2026 permit for property 16411 S. Bass Lake, they were under the impression being a VRBO/AIRBNB – that they were in compliance. No motions made.

Recycling / waste report – Supervisor Dryja gave a brief update. Made mention to check if recycling bill from Oconto County (GFL) dumpsters has been reduced, Clerk/Treasurer Field to follow up. No motions.

Mail and Meetings – Chairman Stemp gave some updates. Town of Doty newsletter mailing has already been getting to residents/property owners, and Chairman Stemp had, along with Supervisor Dryja received some positive feedback. Chairman Stemp discussed his WTA meeting/BOR training, Economic Development Meeting, and the upcoming public hearing in regard to the Camper ordinance.

Approve Payment of Vouchers – Chairman Stemp made motion to approve, Vouchers #13349 - #13386, Federal tax payment #941022026. Quarterly State payment was not due -, seconded by Supervisor Dryja, all were in favor.
