DOVER TOWN BOARD SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

MONDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2025 – 6:00 P.M.

4110 SOUTH BEAUMONT AVENUE (DOVER TOWN HALL) KANSASVILLE, WI 53139

1. **Call to Order:** Chairman Sam Stratton called the Special Meeting to order at 6:00pm.
2. **Roll Call:** Chairman Sam Stratton, 1st Supervisor Mike Shenkenberg, 2nd Supervisor Jared Guillien, and Kansasville Fire Department Chief Ron Molnar
3. **Closed Session under Wisconsin State Statute 19.85(1) Deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session.:** No closed session was held.
4. **Motion to Enter into Open Session:** Not Applicable.
5. **Seagrave Fire Engine Litigation Settlement Overview, Provided by Chief Molnar:** Court mediation was held on October 1, 2025 with Seagrave in one room and Chief Molnar accompanied by Dover's legal counsel in the second room. The mediator would go between the two rooms. A settlement was reached with Seagrave agreeing to pay \$50,000 to compensate for Dover's attorney's fees, and \$16,361.84 for maintenance on the old, Dover's current engine/truck. Seagrave decided to provide the fire engine initially agreed upon at the same contract price of \$789,243 with an extended warrantee, and additional supplements. The new engine should be completed on an accelerated time basis in 2026.
6. **Motion to accept the Seagrave Litigation Settlement:** Jared Guillien made the motion to accept the settlement, seconded by Mike Shenkenberg. Vote: 3/0 (Jared yes, Mike yes, Sam yes) All were in favor. Motion carried.
7. **Public Comments:** No public comments.
8. **Adjournment:** Mike Shenkenberg made the motion to adjourn at 6:26pm, seconded by Jared Guillien. All were in favor. Motion carried.
