

Town of Erin Prairie
Monthly Board Meeting
Monday, June 8, 2026

The town of Erin Prairie monthly Board meeting was called to order Monday, June 8, 2026, by John VanDyk at the Erin Prairie Town Hall at 6:30pm. Present were Board Members John VanDyk, Dennis Mitchell, and Brad Hermansen. Mitchell made a motion to approve the agenda, Hermansen seconded it. Hermansen made a motion to approve the May minutes as written, VanDyk seconded it. Motion passed.

It was reported there is \$235,255.18 in our checking and Money Market Accounts at this time. The bills were presented and discussed. Mitchell made a motion to approve the treasurers report and pay the bills as presented. Hermansen seconded the motion. Motion passed.

There were no Public comments this month.

Jon Sonnetag was available to present the Anderson Trust's new Certified Survey Map. The town board went through the Land Division Ordinance- Town Board Checklist. After reviewing the checklist Mitchell made a motion to approve the new Certified Survey Map, Hermansen seconded it. The new Certified Survey Map for the Anderson Trust was approved.

There were no updates on the Fire and ambulance meetings.

The 140th Ave project is paved, and the gravel on the edges will be filled this week. Crack filling will be getting done on 3 of the newer roads. The discussion opened up about mowing the ditches down, this will be getting done towards the end of June/beginning of July.

Cedar Corp, Albrightson and the township will be meeting soon to discuss and get started on the ARIP project on 190th st.

Liquor licenses applications were presented for Diane Schaub, Rooster's Roadhouse, and Dusty Anderson, Bases Loaded Saloon and application for Class B Beer License and Class C Wine License for Daniel & Shiela Dittman, The Back 80. Mitchell made a motion to approve all applications, Hermansen seconded it. All Liquor License applications were approved.

The Solar Committee is working on a Battery Energy Storage System Ordinance, and incorporating applications to go along with it as well. They are also working on applications for Large and Medium Solar project Permits.

The July meeting will be held Monday, July 13th. At 7:15pm Mitchell made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Hermansen and passed by affirmative vote. Meeting Adjourned.
