"Pursuant to section 376-14, the penalties for the violation of any provision of chapter 376 are found in chapter 20, which addresses citations, and section 1-4. If a person is issued a citation, the provisions of chapter 20 would apply. It calls for a bond scheduled to be created for the violation of various ordinances. If the ordinance is covered in the bond schedule, and one wishes to change the forfeiture contained in the bond schedule, it would require town board action. If the ordinance is not specifically listed in the bond schedule, the schedule should call for an initial bond of \$50-\$1000.
