Board Meeting Minutes

The monthly meeting of the Town of Hustisford was held on Thursday, January 8, 2026.

Present: Chairman Dave Margelofsky (via Microsoft Teams), Supervisor Alvin Hildebrandt, Supervisor Phillip Dahnert, Treasurer Allen Hackbarth, Clerk Agnes Schultz, and Sheriff Dale Schmidt.

Chairman Dave Margelofsky called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. A quorum was present.

Clerk Agnes Schultz verified the posting of the agenda according to state statute.

Public Appearance - None.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve the January 8, 2026 meeting minutes as presented. Alvin Hildebrandt seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report - Alvin Hildebrandt made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented, with \$5,818.30 in the General Fund and \$1,227,431.84 in the NOW Account. Phillip Dahnert seconded. Motion carried.

Roadwork - A log located in the right-of-way on Lehman Road was pushed off the roadway and will need to be removed prior to ditch mowing.

Sheriff Dale Schmidt presented preliminary options for the Dodge County Sheriff's Department to contract with the Town of Hustisford. This was for discussion purposes only; no decision was made.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve the Country Vet Stray Dog Agreement for 2026 in the amount of \$86.00. Alvin Hildebrandt seconded. Motion carried.

Alvin Hildebrandt made a motion to approve Town Board attendance at the WTA District Meeting on Saturday, March 14, 2026, at Old Hickory in Beaver Dam. Phillip Dahnert seconded. Motion carried.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion for the Town Board to attend the WTA Convention October 4-6, 2026, at the Holiday Inn in Stevens Point. Alvin Hildebrandt seconded. Motion carried.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve the purchase of an MS 261 chainsaw from Proven Power. Alvin Hildebrandt seconded. Motion carried.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve the estimate from Roeseler Flooring for the Town Hall. Alvin Hildebrandt seconded. Motion carried.

Alvin Hildebrandt made a motion to approve a donation of \$150.00 to Hustisford High School Post Prom. Phillip Dahnert seconded. Motion carried.

Reports:

Library: The Village and Town of Hustisford will be meeting to discuss funding and overhead funds.

Recreation: The 2026 budget has been approved.

Fire Department: The 2026 budget has been approved. Training has included live fire exercises. A binder lift has been approved. Ice rescue training is upcoming. In 2025, there were 117 fire calls and 153 EMS calls. The annual meeting is scheduled for Saturday, January 31, 2026, at 6:30 PM at the Community Hall.

Alvin Hildebrandt made a motion to approve payment of bills in the amount of \$705,374.62. Phillip Dahnert seconded. Motion carried.
