The monthly meeting of the Town of Hustisford was held on Thursday, April 9, 2026.

Present: Chairman Dave Margelofsky, Supervisor Alvin Hildebrandt, Supervisor Phillip Dahnert, Treasurer Allen Hackbarck, Clerk Agnes Schultz, Arland Kluewer, Ross Roeseler, Bob Driebel, Jamie Mercer, Dave Behl.

Chairman Dave Margelofsky called the meeting to order followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. There was a quorum present.

Clerk Agnes Schultz verified posting the agenda according to State Statute.

Approval of Minutes: Alvin Hildebrandt made a motion to approve the March 5, 2026 minutes as presented, Phillip Dahnert second, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Phillip Dahnert made a motion to accept the Treasurers report as presented with \$2,637.76 in the General Fund and \$147,092.45 in the NOW Account, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

Roadwork: Dave will be contacting Bob Bruha from Scott Construction and Delmore Consulting to set a date to discuss road projects for 2026. A culvert on Oaklawn Road will need patch mix. Stop signs on Arrowhead and Sinissippi Point Road have been replaced. New house number signs have been put up where needed. A new sign for N Garfield Road needs to be ordered. There is still an issue of road signs being stolen.

Alvin Hildebrandt made a motion to approve the Minor Land Division for Mike Bongers, Phillip Dahnert second, motion carried.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve the Conditional Use Permit for Judy Zubke, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

Hubbard/Hustisford Sanitary District #1 Report: Arland Kluewer reported the Sanitary District is possible getting PO Box and also a cell phone for Sanitary District uses only. There are updates being done on the control panels. 27 home owners have been contacted regarding the update. A building permit will be needed for the electrical work. The village is increasing the rated by 8%. Arland Kluewer's term in expiring April 26, 2026. Phillip Dahnert made a motion to reappoint Arland as the Sanitary District Commissioner, (6-year term), Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

The Town Board choose carpeting for the offices and meeting room and vinyl flooring for the chair/table storage room. No action needed to be taken.

Bridge Inspection: Phillip Dahernt made a motion to approve Dodge County Highway Department to do the Town of Hustisford Bridge Inspection, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve the Comprehensive Culvert Service from Delmore Consulting for \$11,600.00 to be put in the 2027 Budget, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve Resolution #1-2026 Supporting a Comprehensive and Sustainable Transportation Funding Solution, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve 2026-2027 WTA/TAC Membership dues for the amount of \$1672.75, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

Alvin Hildebrandt made a motion to approve a Liquor License for the Hustisford Rod and Gun Club effective May 1, 2026, Phillip Dahnert second, motion carried.

Open Book/Board of Review: Meeting date for Open Book and Board of Review meeting to adjourn to a later date was set for Monday, May 4, 2026 at 11:00 am. No action needed to be taken.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve Mr. Green Jean's service for 2026 for the amount of \$1,500.00, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve the Town Board attend WTA Work Zone Training at Old Hickory in Beaver Dam May 6, 2026, 10 am – 2:00 pm, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

Phillip Dahnert made a motion to approve the Town Board to attend Zoning and Land Use Decision Making Workshop at the Dodge County Admin. Building May 20, 2026 5:30 pm – 8:00 pm, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

REPORTS:

Library Report – Library Director Jamie Mercer reported circulation is going up and is fourth in Dodge County. The library is working with the Village to reconcile the balance of the missing funds. They are in the process of hiring a Library Assistant for the summer. A Grant was obtained for a teen internship.

Recreation Report – Phillip Dahnert presented February and March Minutes – Poms has wrapped up; men's basketball and bags end the end of March. Youth Summer Baseball and Softball registration to continue. Swimm Lessons is all set at the TAG Center, Mayville. The school will be doing "on-line" registration this spring for Summer School, The Recreation Department will have a few nights of in person registration at the Village Hall. Hustisford School District is looking for a facility to host summer school.

Fire Department Report - Alvin Hildebrandt reported on the January 2026 minutes – Dodge County is considering redoing the whole radio system County wide. If this is done the Fire Department will also have to redo their system. There is a Grant available for \$50,000.00. Departments will have to put in 20% if the Grant is received. HVAC in community room will be done this summer. EMS received a \$10,000 grant. The year ended with 125 fire calls and 157 EMS calls.

Alvin Hildebrandt made a motion to pay the bills and payroll for the amount of \$18,427.81, Phillip Dahnert second, motion carried.
