Phillip Dahnert made a motion to table hiring and pay rate consideration at this time, Alvin Hildebrandt second, motion carried.

Callista is no longer a staff member, a Team Intern will be starting June 1, 2026, Susie Wearing has been hired as a temporary library assistant and Jason Wisnewski as a shelver. The library approved the summer recreation programs to be held at the library and to open an hour early to accommodate this.
