

JOHNSON TUESDAY NIGHT LIVE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
JOHNSON MUNICIPAL BUILDING
TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 2026

Howard called the meeting to order at 6:07.

Howard said it will cost us \$1 each to have posters printed in the town office. It is the same cost per poster as last year when we had to buy 100, but this year we only need to print as many as we need.

Geoff said if we don't get a bank account attached to the GoFundMe, it will be shut down and the money will be returned. He encouraged committee members to speak to their contacts to keep the fundraising from stalling out. It was agreed to use the existing Venmo account that is in Howard's name. Sophia suggested editing the blurb to explain that all funds will go to the TNL chair's Venmo, to be transferred to the town, in case people are hesitant to donate not knowing where the money will end up.

Howard said Great Big Graphics has all the information they need to make the sponsor signs we are having them make. We will use hand-painted signs for most of the sponsors.

Howard will plan on getting a lift next Tuesday to make repairs to the upper part of the backstop and try putting up some signs as a test run.

Tim and Howard looked at the electrical work that has been done. There is not power to our panel yet, but the panel is in and wired to the meter.

Howard said where he wants to put a road behind the library to the bandstand, the ground may be too muddy to use this year. He has told the selectboard we need 2 entrances to the field for safety, but we probably can get by without the second entrance for this year.

Howard said the bandstand needs some repairs. There is a hole in the floor that is covered with plywood for now. It has dead vines on it that need to be cut off using a stepladder. Sophia offered to work on vine removal.

Howard said he doesn't want to get rid of the old stanchions for sponsor signs until we see how hanging signs on the bandstand works. Others agreed.

There was discussion about things that need to be moved off the bandstand. Howard described what needs to be done to fix the hole. Tim described the electrical components we will need. Howard said we will want to get the mural back up on the bandstand. We need two stepladders to do that.

Tim said he thinks we should revisit placement of the vendor trucks. Maybe it would be better to have them next to the library. It was discussed that the Historical Society has said they would like to use their previous location, but they will not be able to leave early from there, so they may decide they would prefer to be in a different location.

Sophia said we are paying the bands an average of about \$1000 each.

It was agreed to post on Front Porch Forum inviting any nonprofit that wants a table at TNL to contact Tim. Sophia said she can do the Front Porch Forum post.

Tim moved to adjourn at 6:44, Sophia seconded and the motion was passed
