

The regular meeting of the **Longwood Town Board** was called to order at 7:00 p.m., Wednesday October 08, 2025 by Chair Art Petke. Those in attendance were: Art Petke, Travis Greschner, Art Petke III, Sue Devine and Bill Devine.

**AGENDA:** A motion made by Travis Greschner to approve the agenda as presented was seconded by Art Petke. All voted aye.

**MINUTES:** A motion by Travis Greschner to approve the minutes from the September 10, 2025 regular meeting was seconded by Art Petke. All voted aye.

**TREASURER:** A motion made by Travis Greschner to accept the September 30, 2025 treasurer's report was seconded by Art Petke. All voted aye.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** The clerk provided samples of notices that were received from Stanley Minnick of One Energy. One Energy will be publishing information about the project in Local Information Sources.

A motion was made by Art Petke to update the town website was seconded by Travis Greschner.

Art Petke will look into the property on the South East corner of Hwy N & Hwy 73.

The treasurer reported that the Truck \$61k CD at Sterling Bank has been renewed at 4% interest rate.

**ROADS:** The clerk was instructed to look into listing the 2010 patrol truck for sale in the Wisconsin Surplus Auction web site with no minimum asking price.

Art Petke reported that he left a message with J.J. Brush Cutting about fall cutting of the ditches and old dump but has not gotten a return call.

Art Petke noted that there are trees in the ditch area on Weaver Zimmermans land along Resewood Ave. that are getting quite large. Art will contact Weaver Zimmerman about how to deal with the trees.

Art Petke reviewed and signed a map of the town's roads for the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and a copy of the map will be retained at the town hall.

The clerk will look into the completion of the WISLR Pavement Road Rating Report that is due by December 15, 2025.

**ZONING:** The zoning administrator reported that letter to Tyler Turner was returned as undeliverable.

**PARK:**

**Employee Report:** The replacement of the two shop garage doors with one large door was ordered and is on the list with Garage Doors Unlimited.

The poly side boards are ready to be installed on 2026 patrol truck. The truck will need to be taken in to Monroe to get the work done or Monroe may pick up the truck if they are in the area.

**MEETINGS:** Art Petke reported that Owen, Withee, Curtiss Fire District assessments had been distributed and the amassment to be paid by the Town of Longwood in 2026 is \$50,430.54.

Art Petke reported that the fire district is looking into building a new fire station East of Owen on the South side of Hwy 29 in the industrial park. The proposed cost is \$3.5 million. Art also noted that the Curtiss fire hall is still being offered as a new fire hall at a cost of approximately \$1 million.

The proposed budget for the fire district showed a reduction in wages sighting a loss of volunteers which raised questions about building a new fire hall is there are not enough volunteers to man the district.

**PAYMENT OF BILLS:** A motion by Travis Greschner to pay the bills seconded by Art Petke. All voted aye.

**CORRESPONDENCE:** Gathered correspondence from the month was weeded through and appropriate action taken.

**ADJOURN:** A motion to adjourn the meeting by Travis Greschner was seconded by Art Petke at 8:35 p.m. All voted aye.
