The regular meeting of the Longwood Town Board was called to order at 7:00 p.m., Wednesday April 8, 2026 by Chair Art Petke. Those in attendance were: Art Petke, Travis Greschner, Art Petke III, Sue Devine and Bill Devine.

Absent: Jeff Rasmussen

AGENDA: A motion made by Travis Greschner to approve the agenda was seconded by Art Petke. All voted aye.

MINUTES: A motion by Travis Greschner to approve the minutes from the March 04, 2026 regular meeting was seconded by Art Petke. All voted aye.

TREASURER: A motion made by Travis Greschner to accept the March 31, 2026 treasurer's report was seconded by Art Petke. All voted aye.

PUBLIC COMMENT: The clerk was instructed to set up a tire collection day for late August.

ROADS: Bids for 4,000 yards of both gravel and blue granite and dust control for 30,000 gallons more or less were opened by chair Art Petke as follows:

A motion by Art Petke to purchase 30,000 gallons, more or less, of Calcium Chloride from Slobodnik Gravel and Excavating was seconded by Travis Greschner. All voted aye.

A motion by Travis Greschner to purchase 4,000 yards, more or less, of both Blue Granite and Gravel from Haas Sons was seconded by Art Petke. All voted aye.

A motion by Art Petke to pass an ordinance making Fairground Avenue from Hwy 29 to Eddy Road and Colby Factory Road from Hwy 73 to Hwy O Class B Roads was seconded by Travis Greschner. All voted aye. Ordinance #040826.

Fines per offense are as follows: 1st offense, \$250, 2nd offense \$263 plus overweight and damage fines. Infractions should be reported to the Wisconsin State Patrol at 715-839-3800.

A motion by Art Petke to enter into a Hixwood Road maintenance agreement with the Town of Hixon where Hixon is assigned the Western .75-mile portion of Hixwood Road and Longwood will be assigned the Eastern .75 miles of Hixwood Road. Longwood will fully maintain the .25-mile portion of road just east of Frenchtown Ave. and will invoice Hixon in the first quarter of each year for the GTA equivalent as a maintenance fee.

The annual road inspection trip was set for April 26th at 7:00 a.m.

ZONING: The Treasurer reported that she contacted the Wisconsin Towns Association about residents who have overdue tax bills and the town confirmed that the correct process is being followed and any further action will be initiated by the county.

The town received an anonymous note asking when the Flemming property on Owen Ave will be cleaned up. Art Petke contacted Paige Linder at Clark County and she asked that a copy of the letter be sent to her. The clerk will email a copy.

The Treasurer informed the board that letters will be mailed the week of 4/13/26 to any residents who have not yet paid their dog taxes informing them of the potential of fines for non-compliance.

PARK: Art Petke III reported that both portable toilets at the park had been damaged. While trying to identify the vehicle that did the damage the person who had caused the damage came to the park and volunteered to make full restitution for the damages and do whatever needed to be done to make up for the damages. The town did not press charges.

Employee Report: The shop roof has not yet been repaired. There is an issue with an area that may have had an exhaust pipe coming out of the roof that will need patching before any new coating can be applied.

MEETINGS: Art Petke reported that the fire district has been in contact with Tammy Baldwin and she has agreed to try to help the fire district secure some grant funds.

PAYMENT OF BILLS: A motion by Travis Greschner to pay the bills seconded by Art Petke. All voted aye.

CORRESPONDENCE: Gathered correspondence from the month was weeded through and appropriate action taken.

ADJOURN: A motion to adjourn the meeting by Art Petke was seconded by Travis Greschner at 8:50 p.m. All voted aye.
