Minutes of August 24, 2026

- Minutes of the July 27, 2026 Town Board Meeting. A motion to approve the Minutes of July 27, 2026 Town Board Meeting with one correction was made by Herrick/Olson. Motion carried.

With schools starting they are working with Waukesha County Sheriff Department. Asst. Chief Hoffman gave an up-to-date report for the Board. There has been an increase from last year's call volume.
