Discussion on Town of Merton Levy Limits and Calculations from the State.

The board reviewed the levy limits for the 2026 budget and how much the Town levy is allowed to increase to. The increase is much lower than what it has been in the past three years. Based on the State Statue on funding Libraries a higher percentage of the levy will have to dedicated to the library in order to exempt from county tax.

Discussion of Budgets and Management of Tax Payers Funds and Funding from other Sources. Both boards had discussion of the operating/capital budget for the library and the town board concerns of required funding. A request was made to see if the library board could have a special meeting to submit an operating budget and capital budget to the town board as soon as possible. The Library Board was going to set that up.
