May 13, 2026

The monthly board meeting of the Town of New Haven was called to order by Chairperson Jeff Carlsrud at the New Haven Town Hall on Wednesday, May 13, 2026, 7:09 pm.

ROLL CALL

Carlsrud, S. Bartz, Bovee, and M. Bartz were present. Patrolman also present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by S. Bartz, second by Carlsrud, to approve the meeting minutes for April 21, 2026, as distributed. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT

M. Bartz gave the treasurer report:

CLERK'S REPORT

Bovee reported that she is continuing to work on the Municipal Financial Report for the State. Additionally, she prepared the paperwork for the truck loan and received an email from a townspeople regarding fence judging.

CHAIR'S REPORT

Carlsrud reported back from the WTA Unit meeting. The WTA is working to negotiate for towns for continued financial support with the \$2 billion state surplus. The bridge inspection project is continuing. There was much discussion at the unit meeting regarding weight restrictions reinforcement.

PATROLMAN'S REPORT

Trent reported that he is hauling gravel. There is a culvert needing replacement on 220th that qualifies for the County Bridge Petition. Black top patching is almost done, with two spots left. The new pickup truck is working well. The wiring is still needed for bracket and harness.

The board further discussed selling the old pickup truck. Motion by S. Bartz, second by Carlsrud, to sell the old town pickup truck at Hanson's Auction Group. Motion carried unanimously.

The board discussed the 2026 roadwork projects. Motion by Carlsrud, second by S. Bartz, to approve chipsealing on 1290th Ave from Co Q to 30th St and chipsealing on 110th St from St Hwy 64 to Co Q. Motion carried unanimously.

The board discussed the 2026 roadwork projects. Motion by Carlsrud, second by S. Bartz, to approve pulverizing 145th from Co K to 1390th Ave. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by S. Bartz, second by Carlsrud, to approve paying the bills as presented in the check detail
Motion carried unanimously.
